Ms. Veronique is the Music and ICT teacher at St. Francis School B'Kara. When approached by the head with the idea of a new CD, she was enthusiastic for the challenge that this would bring. This CD brought about an opportunity for the choir to perform in special occasions, where they would learn more than ever, how to work hard for a common goal.
